What is the School Advisory Council? School Advisory Councils (SAC) were created by the Florida legislature in 1991 out of concern about the effectiveness of public schools. The main purpose of SAC is, in collaboration with the principal and the school, to develop, implement and evaluate a written plan for school improvement, using the School Improvement and Education Accountability System's priorities and student performance standards. CHS SAC does that and so much more! Meeting presentations include:

- Online resource information for parents and students regarding:
 - (1) Academic planning and evaluations.
 - (2) Parent Connect resources, information, and instructions and tips for using the site.
 - (3) ePEP (Personal Education Planner).
 - (4) Career choices, resources and information for parents and students.
 - (5) Graduation options.
 - (6) Bright Futures information, requirements, planning and tracking.
 - (7) Florida Virtual School information.
- FCAT information, resources, the school's grade, your child's preparation and readiness, etc.
- Academy, facility, and faculty information and updates.
- Campus Activities and Special Events information and updates.
- College resources and information for parents and students regarding:
 - (1) Preparation and education requirements, suggestions, and guidance.
 - (2) The latest on college scholarships, admissions requirements, etc.
 - (3) College entrance test information including American College Test (ACT), College Placement Test (CPT), Scholastic Aptitude Test (SAT), & SAT online prep programs.
- Tarpon Parent University.
