

Operation of Motor Vehicles and Parking on Campus

Students must obtain a valid parking permit prior to parking on campus. Parking without a valid parking permit is NOT allowed and all violators will be booted or towed at the vehicle owner's risk and expense.

The right to drive a motor vehicle is controlled by the state of Florida through the Department of Highway, Safety, and Motor Vehicles. Various laws and regulations control the operation of a motor vehicle for the safety of all concerned and should be viewed as a privilege. The privilege to operate a motor vehicle is also a tremendous responsibility. It should be noted that the operation of a motor vehicle on Charlotte County Public Schools property is a **privilege** and still under the control of the state of Florida through the Department of Highway, Safety, and Motor Vehicles and all applicable laws and regulations. Parking at Charlotte High School is limited due to space and students should treat their parking privilege with great respect. Student parking on Charlotte County Public Schools property (**to include but not limited to Charlotte High, Sallie Jones Elementary, Punta Gorda Middle or Educational Support Services**) is by permit only. Parking without authorization or a current parking permit is forbidden **and all violators will be booted or towed at vehicle owner's expense.** All students who drive to school must register their vehicle(s) and secure a **parking permit to be displayed on the lower corner of the drivers' side front and rear windows.** Regulations and use of the student parking privilege are stated on the Parking Agreement. A Parking permit may be issued upon satisfactory completion of the Parking Agreement.
