

Senior End of Course Exam Waiver

NOTE: Official State of Florida End of Course (EOC) Exams cannot be waived.

I, _____, (print) hereby request to be waived from my final exam(s). I have met the following requirements of the Charlotte County School Board's Student Progression Plan for examination waiver:

1. Only seniors can waive exams.
2. Exam waivers do not pertain to AP tests and dual credit exams required by colleges.
3. The semester exam in a course that is year-long, such as English or math, etc. can only be waived at the end of the entire course.
4. A semester exam for a course can only be waived at the end of course.
5. Students must have:
 - no more than five tardies for the semester
 - Tardies between May 8th and May 12th **WILL NOT** count toward this total
 - no external suspensions for the semester
 - Discipline issues between May 8th and May 12th **MAY** affect your waiver status
 - an overall "A" or "B" average in the course
 - no more than 5 absences for the semester
 - Absences between May 8th and May 12th **WILL NOT** count toward this total
6. **The waiver must be signed by the student's parent/guardian and teacher. It must be submitted for administrative approval no later than Friday, May 5, 2017.**

NOTE: When an exam is waived, the two nine-week letter grades for that semester will be averaged to obtain a semester average for the course.
