3. The use of alcohol and /or drugs is prohibited. Any affiliation will result in disciplinary action by school administration as per School Board policies and the Code of Student Conduct. You may also face disciplinary action by the head coach.
4. You are expected to demonstrate great work ethic and character while at practice every day. Do what you are asked to do with pride. It is an honor and a privilege to be an athlete at CHS. It is something you will be proud of and remain a part of for the rest of your life. RESPECT the program and those who played before you since 1926. Demonstrate this through your dedication and work ethic.
5. Treat your locker room with respect. You spend a lot of time here. Keep it clean. Keep trash picked up. Keep articles hung in your locker. Keep all clothes washed on a regular basis. Take pride in your locker room.
