

SCHOLARSHIP SEARCH SUGGESTIONS

Florida Bright Futures: Check eligibility status through FloridaShines account; accounts are updated following each semester (January and June)

- FAS – Florida Academic Scholarship
- FMS – Florida Medallion Scholarship
- GSV – Gold Seal Vocational

First Generation Scholarships: Available to students whose parents have not received a 4 year Bachelor of Arts or Science degree.

Institutional Scholarships: Scholarships offered by college/university you commit to attend. Find these scholarships by looking at the Scholarships/Financial Aid page of each institution's web site. Submission of admission application by fall due date, automatically considers you for many institution's scholarships. College/university will notify you of available financial aid offers upon acceptance.
