

Student ID FAQs



Q: When can I pick up my student ID?

A: Student IDs arrive from the photography company approximately 3-4 weeks after underclassmen picture days.

Q: Where can I pick up my new student ID?

A: In the Media Center

Q: Do I have to pay for it?

A: Student IDs are sent to us by the photography company. Any ID they have sent to us is free. If you missed all picture days and retakes, we will take your picture and make you one free ID.

Q: What happens if I lose my ID?

A: It is \$5.00 to get a replacement ID if there is not one in the drawer from the photography company.

Q: Why do I need a student ID?

A: Your ID has your Student ID number which is needed for logging into your computer accounts and other school programs. There are many events that require you to provide your student ID. Among them are: buying tickets for and attending Homecoming and Prom, Renaissance membership, checking out textbooks, and attending senior events, including eating lunch in the picnic area.

Q: What is Renaissance?

A: The Renaissance Program is designed to reward students by providing exclusive access to special events and the end-of-year Renaissance Assembly at which over \$13,000 of prizes are given away. To qualify students must have a 3.0 grade point average or higher, or improve their grade point average by 0.5 from the last nine weeks; must not miss more than 4 days of school during the last nine weeks, and must not be tardy more than 9 times during the last nine weeks.
